What to do when an unauthorized person has registered a domain name?

There are times when domain names have been registered by an unauthorized holder. There may be situations such as:

- Unauthorized persons have registered domain names in the identity of legitimate companies
- Unauthorized persons have registered domain names in legitimate companies organization numbers, but with other contact and address information
- Unauthorized persons have registered domain names in the identity of other private individuals
- Unauthorized persons have registered domain names in the identity of other private individuals, but with other contact and address information.

If such a case is discovered, you can send an email to the registrar of the domain name. Contact details for our registrars can be found <u>here</u>.

If the registrar does not respond, you can send an email to abuse@internetstiftelsen.se and inform them about the matter. The abuse function will then assess the situation for further handling of the case.
