### Organization Number Formats

Below are examples of organization and personal identity number formats from different countries. This list may be updated over time.

COUNTRY	ORGANIZATION NUMBER	PERSONAL IDENTITY NUMBER	NOTES
<b>Denmark</b>	8 digits "NNNNNNNN"	11 digits "DDMMYY-NNNN"	CVR - For Danish companies, the CVR number must be provided.
<b>Norway</b>	9 digits "NNNNNNNNN"	11 digits "DDMMYYNNCC"	
<b>Finland</b>	9 digits "NNNNNNN-N"	11 digits "DDMMYY-NNNC" or "DDMMYYANNNC"	
<b>Switzerland</b>	CHE + 9 digits "CHENNNNNNNNN" "CHE-NNN.NNN.NNN"		Every Swiss company has a business identification number. This UID can be requested online. The number always consists of the prefix "CHE" and a 9-digit number containing a control number. For example, "CHE987654321" or "CHE-112.007.423"

<b>Italy</b>	11 digits "NNNNNNNNNNN"		The codice fiscale for entities (business, foundations, etc.) is a random number assigned by the Italian Tax Office. <a href="https://italianbusinessregister.it/en/home">https://italianbusinessregister.it/en/home</a>

<b>Germany</b>	HRB + digits HRA + digits (number of digits may vary) Example: HRB123456 HRA12345		Commercial Register Number - the most commonly used company identifier in Germany. HRB is used for corporations (e.g. GmbH, AG) and HRA for partnerships (e.g. OHG, KG). The prefix is followed by a sequential number whose length may vary.
